I . Basic Operations of the Congress

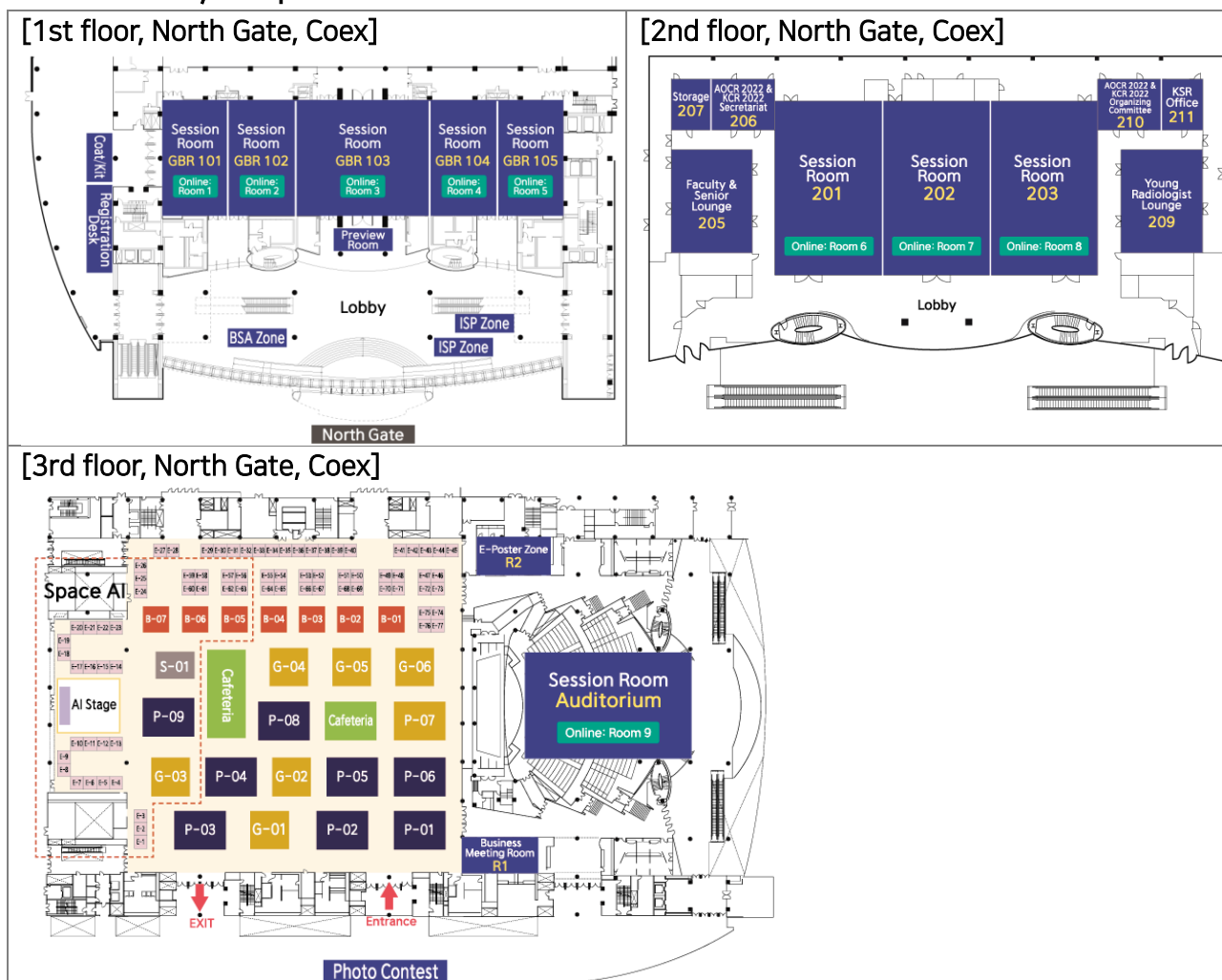
1. Basic operating strategy

- Provide a safe congress environment for all participants by strictly adhering to the quarantine guidelines issued by the government

2. Basic operating principle

- Follow the quarantine regulations and safety measures for COVID-19 including the wearing of masks
- (Notice) In case the PCR test is divided into confirmed cases and quarantined, the invited speaker, chairperson and presenter must bring your personal laptop.

II. Airport Quarantine Response

1. Main points and flow chart

1) Key quarantine-related information

◆ **Suspension of request for negative test result confirmation prior entry (from September 3, 2022)**

- Passengers on board must comply with quarantine guidelines such as mandatorily wearing a mask
- In the event of the discovery of a person with COVID-19 symptoms on board, the airline will reassign seating on its discretion, notify the quarantine station in advance and give priority disembarkation to such person.
- For the safety of yourself and other passengers, it is recommended that you isolate and receive treatment locally if you exhibit symptoms and test positive for COVID-19 while abroad.

◆ **All entrants are recommended to take a PCR test at the COVID-19 Testing Center located within each airport upon arrival.**

◆ **Quarantine Information System (Q-CODE) Operation Guide**

- Full implementation for passengers arriving through airports and to be expanded to include arrivals through ports in the future
- Users of the Q-CODE system can confirm their health status with their QR code (no separate submission of documents)
- You MUST register the Day 1 after arrival PCR Test result on Q-CODE.

◆ **The mandatory quarantine for an entrant to Korea is lifted on June 8.**

- There is no mandatory quarantine, regardless of your history of vaccination, a type of visa etc. (only those with confirmed infection will be quarantined).

◆ **Subject to change in the event of future emergence of new mutations or any situational change here or abroad**

2) Quarantine response guideline (since July 25, 2022)

* How to move: All foreigners can use car or taxi when moving from the airport to their homes Definition of "short-term foreign visitor"

* Recommend waiting until PCR test results are confirmed at home and accommodation

* Registered on the Quarantine Information Pre-Input System (Q-CODE) website as a result of the inspection

2. Quarantine-related immigration process

<p>◆ After entering the country, take a PCR test within 24 hours and register the PCR test result on the Q-CODE website.</p> <p>*How to register</p> <p>① Visit the website (https://cov19ent.kdca.go.kr/cpassport/biz/beffatstmnt/main.do?lang=en)</p> <p>② Click the 'Registration of post-entry inspection' button.</p>

1) Testing

- Required for all entrants from overseas (including Koreans).
- Main process
 - Undergo a special immigration process including having body temperature (heat monitoring camera, eardrum thermometer, etc.) and pre-filled health status questionnaire checked, etc.
 - Take post-entry COVID-19 test and register the test result in the Q-CODE system.

3. Testing and measures for symptomatic cases

1) Criteria

All passengers arriving in Korea from overseas showing signs of fever (37.5°C or higher), coughing, difficulty in breathing, and/or other possible signs of COVID-19 within 21 days of arrival date

2) Testing

- Upon classification, temporary isolation in a quarantine observation facility or room after sample collection
- Confirmation of classification after verifying the health status of entrant including checking fever and health status questionnaire, etc.
- Transfer to quarantine observation facility or room, etc.
- Temporary isolation and sample collection at the quarantine observation facility or room
- Measures taken to transfer patient to a hospital such as the National Medical Center in case of severity of symptom(s)

3) Response according to test result

- Positive: transfer to home, hospital or treatment center depending on severity of symptom(s)
- Negative: follow the procedure for asymptomatic cases (the PCR test required within 24 hours after entry is deemed to have been completed)

4. Testing and measures for asymptomatic cases

1) Testing

- Classification after checking fever and health status questionnaire

2) Response

- Obligatory PCR testing on Day 1 and follow-up RAT recommended on Day 6 or 7 after arrival
- Short-term foreign visitors
 - ① Take PCR test on the first day after entering the country at the COVID-19 Testing Center at the airport (at one's own expense).
 - * Testing may be conducted at a medical clinic near the visitor's accommodation in case of unavoidable circumstances.
 - ② After taking the PCR test, take a personal car or a quarantine taxi to the place of accommodation and wait until the test result comes out.
 - ③ Follow-up with the recommended RAT on Day 6 or 7 after arrival (at one's own expense).

III. Allocation of Isolation Ward or Treatment Center

1. Assignment of isolation ward per symptom type

1) Confirmed cases with severe symptoms or from high-risk groups

- Incheon International Airport COVID-19 Testing Center: Request the assignment of isolation ward to the National Medical Center regardless of the nationality of the patient
 - * However, in the event of an emergency patient showing such symptoms as sudden aggravation of difficulty in breathing or loss of consciousness, etc., he/she will be transferred to a designated hospital for infectious diseases in the Incheon area regardless of the patient's area of residence or accommodation. Information will be shared with the municipal/provincial government of the patient's area of residence or accommodation.
- Other quarantine centers: Contact the liaison officer of the city/province in which the quarantine center is located and have ward or treatment center assigned by the patient management department within the municipal/provincial government. Request support to the National Medical Center in case of shortage of ward in the city/province where the quarantine center is located.

2) Confirmed cases with no or mild symptoms

- Incheon International Airport COVID-19 Testing Center: Patients sent home for treatment by private car or quarantine taxi regardless of nationality
 - * Short-term foreign visitors will be transferred to the treatment center designated by the Central Disaster and Safety Countermeasure Headquarters ([Hotel Ora in Yeongjongdo](#)).
- Other quarantine centers: Contact the liaison officer of the city/province in which the quarantine center is located and have ward or treatment center assigned by the patient management department within the municipal/provincial government.

2. Transfer of confirmed cases

- Persons subject to home treatment: Return home using their own car or a quarantine taxi
- Persons who cannot be treated at home: Transfer to a hospital or treatment center and confirm arrival by telephone
- Persons being transferred must wear a KF94 mask during the transfer.

3. Information on location of isolation ward or treatment center

1) Confirmed cases from Incheon International Airport COVID-19 Testing Center

- Reservation and isolation of accommodation
 - * Accommodation reservation and seven-day quarantine are required for confirmed patients directly on the 'Airbnb' or 'Wehome' website
 - * Internet environment needs to be checked before booking accommodation

2) Confirmed cases from Gangnam-gu District Public Health Center

- * If you are confirmed positive at a screening clinic at the Gangnam-gu Health Center, [you must book an accommodation through 'Airbnb or Wehome' site and quarantine at the accommodation.](#)

IV. Measures for Suspected Cases

1. Step-by-step protocol

- Provide information to patient about voluntary reporting to the public health center
- After accompanying the patient to the ambulance, disinfect contact areas
- Follow-up if needed after the patient is treated
